Powered by a reliable 9 HP Robin Subaru engine for easy start, low emissions and quiet operation, the Maxus 140 provides welding output from 60 to 140 AC amps to weld up to 3/8" steel. Boasting a 35 percent duty cycle at 140 amps, the Maxus 140 is the choice for high-demand users.

The Maxus 140 features a 7-gallon gas tank and is equipped with three outlets: two (2) 20-amp, 115-volt GFCI and one (1) 20-amp, 120/240-volt twistlock. External dinse plugs make it quick and easy and to change leads. A welding helmet, 10' leads and cable wrap are included. The suggested retail price is \$1,175.
