

New Air Compressor Cuts the Cord

The FP2400 weighs just 20 pounds and features a foam grip handle and built-in air reservoir for easy transport from basement or garage to campsite or backyard. Powered by a built-in rechargeable battery, the unit's compact motor delivers .7 SCFM at 90 PSI (with a maximum 140 PSI) and operates at a quiet 68 decibels.

The FP2400 also features a rugged shroud to protect internal components; an accessory storage bin for plugs, inflation needles and nozzles; and built-in air regulator with automatic shut off.
